## Background

This protein is activated leukocyte cell adhesion molecule (ALCAM), also known as CD166 (cluster of differentiation 166), which is a member of a subfamily of immunoglobulin receptors with five immunoglobulin-like domains (VVC2C2C2) in the extracellular domain. This protein binds to T-cell differentiation antigen CD6, and is implicated in the processes of cell adhesion and migration. Multiple alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found.

## Basic Information

### Description

Active Recombinant Human ALCAM/CD166 Protein is produced by HEK293 expression system. The target protein is expressed with sequence (Met1-Ala526) of human ALCAM/CD166 (Accession #NP\_001618.2) fused with an Fc, 6xHis tag at the C-terminus.

### Bio-Activity

Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized Human CD6 at 1 μg/mL (100 μL/well) can bind Human CD166 with a linear range of 0.05-1.2 ng/mL.

### Storage

Store the lyophilized protein at -20°C to -80 °C for long term.

After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20 °C for 3 months, at 2-8 °C for up to 1 week.


Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.


